YOUR PLANS FOR THE FUTURE

Now is the perfect time to plan ahead, care for loved ones, and support the causes that matter most to you. If you're passionate about ending hunger, consider including Action Against Hunger in your plans for the future:

- **Bequest:** Include Action Against Hunger in your will or trust by designating a specific amount, percentage, asset, or remainder. This simple, revocable gift has no impact on your current finances.
- **Beneficiary Designation:** Name Action Against Hunger as a beneficiary of your bank or brokerage account, life insurance policy, or retirement plan. This bypasses probate and may offer tax benefits.
- **Retirement Account:** If you're 70½ or older, you can make a tax-free donation from your traditional IRA through your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD), potentially lowering your taxable income.
- **Donor-Advised Fund (DAF):** Without a named beneficiary, DAF providers choose where remaining funds go. Naming Action Against Hunger ensures your generosity supports families facing hunger.

OUR IMPACT IN ACTION: RASHAEI'S STORY

When two-year-old Rashaei from Kenya became weak and ill, his mother, Nolntulan, feared for his life. Luckily, Action Against Hunger's Community Health Worker, Patrick, arrived just in time. He diagnosed Rashaei with malnutrition and referred him to our nearest health clinic, where Rashaei received therapeutic food, vitamins, immunizations, and other care. After six weeks, Rashaei returned to his playful self. Action Against Hunger also enrolled Nolntulan in a mother-to-mother support group to learn about child nutrition and healthy cooking.
